Spiritual Heritage Education Network - 3

- Goals: Intelligibility and Meaning
- Expected Outcome: Human condition capable of:
 - Understanding of the true face of one's own religion and of the others
 - ➢ Tolerance and respect of all religions
 - >Mutual understanding, love and respect
 - ➢Non-discrimination
 - ➢Understanding of differences
 - ≻Feeling of unity in diversity
 - ≻Just and sustainable world

What is spirit?

Spirit to us means any or all of the following:

- Essence hidden under physicality
- Meaning hidden underneath expression
- Life and consciousness
- Intellectual and mental existence apart from the physical existence
- The divine spark underlying all existence

Ultimate Reality and Spirituality

- Ultimate reality is that:
 Out of which all is born
 In which all is sustained
 - ≻Into which all finally dissolves
- Spirituality is the ability to see the oneness of all beings through the oneness of our underlying reality
- One is spiritual to the extent one experiences this unity in diversity

Essence of Being

- Ultimate reality is the underlying essence of all beings. It is understood as the inseparable unity of two principles:
- 1. Principle of Becoming (Change)
 - Everything and every being is continually changing
- 2. Principle of Being, in the sense of:
 - Unchanging Enabler of Becoming that in us and the universe which itself does not change and which drives the change
 - Current State of Becoming


Change and constancy comprise the very nature of all beings.

Spiritual Development - 1

Spiritual Development lies in:

- Taking charge of the principle of becoming as it applies to an individual
- Preventing the limited mind, conscious and unconscious, from taking control of what we become
- Directing the Principle of Becoming in the light of the Principle of Being



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Measure of Spiritual Development

• Spiritual development = 0%

≻Born totally self-centered through the body

≻Life run by the sensory faculty alone

≻We see ourselves as separate and divided

• Spiritual development = 100%

>Perfect ordering of the senses and reason to the spirit

≻Totally centered on ultimate reality

➤We see ultimate reality in ourselves as in all others in a unity of being

Need for Spiritual Education

- Counter powerful divisive forces
- Promote oneness of human family
- Counter intolerance
- Promote understanding, love and respect
- Build a just and sustainable world
- Develop inner human being in step with developments in science and technology
- Constructively channel human energy

Nature of Ultimate Reality

- It is the efficient and the material cause of all that exists
- Ultimate reality is ONE by definition
- Being the source of infinity, it is infinite, without limitation of time and space
- Being infinite, it is indescribable in finite words
- We can only have our perspectives about it
- It lends itself to three types of perspectives:
 Spiritual: in terms of essence and meaning of things
 Physical: in terms of the perceptible universe
 Divine: in terms of divine personalities

Why Ultimate Reality Based Education?

- Intelligent & meaningful explanation of all beings
- Intelligibility and meaning are basic human needs
- Inclusive and harmonizing Concept
- Embraces all knowledge disciplines & all religions
- Being the underlying cause of all, it unites us all and inspires feelings of unity and inclusiveness
- Weakens feelings of divisiveness
- Potential of deep human transformation

Two Ways of Learning about Ultimate Reality

- Cognitively by studying:
 - Our physical existence
 - Our sustenance
 - Our dissolution
- Conatively through grace by willing the reality to reveal itself through insight and intuition

More on Learning about Ultimate Reality

- Infinite reality is unknowable completely
- We can only develop perspectives
- Perspectives of ultimate reality are of three types:
 > Spiritual: in terms of essence and meaning of things
 > Physical

Divine: in terms of divine personalities

• No perspective is as meaningful and transformative as when internalized and experienced conatively by each individual

Assumptions in Spiritual Education


- Individual exists and the universe exists
- Proof lies in our consciousness
- There is ONE reality underlying all existence
- Perceptions of underlying reality differ
- An individual perception is not negotiable
- The universe is infinite and so is the reality
- All beings are ultimately ONE in the oneness of their reality
- One can be exclusive in one's own religious commitment and inclusive in respecting others
- Being faithful and reasonable are not mutually exclusive

Ethics of Spiritual Education - 1

- Ethic of underlying oneness of all in general
- No discrimination, affirmation, denial or diminishing of any religion, culture, race, etc.
- Strictly academic considerations, no preaching and proselytising
- Acknowledge due academic credits
- Complement other education, encompass entire humanity and totality of human experience
- Learning must be multi-disciplined, nonjudgmental, non-partisan, inclusive, meaningful and conducive to inner growth

Ethics of Spiritual Education - 2

• Encourage and promote: Exclusive practice of chosen religion ► Tolerance, understanding, love, and respect >Inclusiveness and sustainability >Building of a just human family within the world community ≻Unifying and not divisive Harmony with sense perception and reason



- Development process for the learning material:
 - Learn & Relearn
 - Interpret & Reinterpret
 - Harmonize
 - Crystallize
 - Educate
 - ✤ Initially internet courses in distance education mode
 - ✤ Goal: As an integral part of the public educational system

Scope of Spiritual Education

- Human Essence Various Perspectives on:
 - > Spiritual development and human relations
 - Body, mind, reason, thought, will, senses, feelings, sensations, consciousness and the life force
 - Determinants and transformation of human condition
- Universal Essence Various perspectives on:
 - Underlying reality: Being and Becoming
 - ➤ Genesis, sustenance and dissolution
 - > Human family in the global community
- Perspectives on meaning and purpose of being human and how to fulfill them
- Spiritual Ethics: Ways of living our spiritual unity

Types Of Courses

- Individually Developed
 - Relevant courses of individual specialties
 - Taught by the course developer
 - Teacher compensation: Per student basis
- Collaboratively Developed
 - Many developers one teacher
 - Developer Compensation basis: Per module
 - Teacher compensation basis: Per student

Strategy of Collaborative Development

- Define independent modules in each course
- Module = 3 hours of in-class instruction
- Course = 12 to 14 modules
- Identify experts for developing modules
- Provide guidelines for module developers
- Receive developed modules and integrate
- Post the course on the web

Core Study Areas

- Ultimate Reality & the Individual *Purpose: Intelligibility through various perspectives*
- Meaning & Purpose *Purpose: Search through various perspectives*
- Contemplation Methods

Purpose: Theory and practice of contemplation for experiential understanding of personal essence and underlying unity, personal search for meaning and purpose

• Spiritual Ethics

Purpose: Practical ways of living the unity of being

Supporting Study Areas

- Religious Leaders & Literature *Purpose: A study of spiritual exemplars and role models*
- Philosophy & Psychology Purpose: Understanding first principles of spirituality
- Theology & Mythology *Purpose: Understanding through various perspectives*
- Physical & Life Science *Purpose: Scientific bases for intelligibility*

Conclusions

- Universal spirituality is rooted in the oneness of ultimate reality, yet allowing for different perspectives
- Possible to develop courses in universal spirituality without affirming or diminishing any religion
- Scope of such an education is defined & a proposal for a curriculum is presented to complement traditional education
- It is proposed to use human resources worldwide and offer courses worldwide initially in distance mode on the internet
- It is hoped that traditional in-class offerings of developed course material will emerge once we do an excellent job of curriculum development.

A Special Opportunity

- Physically, the world has become a global village
- We must learn to live as one human family within the earth community in this global village
- Creation of one family urgently needs the oneness of hearts inherent in human spirituality
- Spirituality underlies religion and presents its true face
- Serious URAM students worldwide have an obligation to lead in the shaping of one human family
